



ROVER 2018 CLUB MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

MSA EASTERN PROVINCE MOTORSPORT CIRCULAR EP 11/2018

1. **CONTROLLERS AND CLUB NAME:**

Club Name: Rover Motorcycle Club

Controllers: Rover Club MX Committee

2. **AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP:**

The Rover Motorcycle Club MX Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the 2018 Rover Motorcycle Club Championship in the following bike classes; however it is entitled to withhold such declaration from any competition, should circumstances warrant such action.

3. **CLASSES AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:**

3.1 **50cc Support Auto Clutch (air or water cooled)**

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 4th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 7th birthday occurs.
- b) 2 Stroke air & water cooled not exceeding 52cc.
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 10" (rear) and 12" (front)
- d) Non-Championship Class

3.2 **50cc Pro Auto Clutch (air or water cooled)**

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 5th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 9th birthday occurs.
- b) 2 Stroke air & water cooled not exceeding 52cc.
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 10" (rear) and 12" (front)

3.3 **65cc Novice**

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 8th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 10th birthday occurs.
- b) Clutch lever with gears not to exceed 65cc.
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 12" (rear) and 14" (front)





3.4 MX 65cc

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 8th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 10th birthday occurs.
- b) Clutch lever with gears not to exceed 65cc.
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 12" (rear) and 14" (front)

3.5 MX 85cc

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 8th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 15th birthday occurs.
- b) Clutch lever with gears not to exceed 85cc 2 stroke and 150cc 4 stroke motorcycles
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 14" (rear) and 17" (front) or 16" (rear) and 19" (front)

3.6 MX 125cc

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 13th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 17th birthday occurs.
- b) 125cc 2 Stroke motorcycles not exceeding only
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 19" (rear) and 21" (front)

3.7 MX2

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 16th birthday and older
- b) 125cc 2 stroke not exceeding 250cc 4 stroke motorcycles
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 19" (rear) and 21" (front)

3.8 MX1

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 16th birthday and older
- b) 250cc 2 stroke not exceeding 450cc 4 stroke motorcycles
- c) Wheel diameter not exceeding 19" (rear) and 21" (front)

3.9 MX3

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 38th birthday and older
- b) Wheel Size – Rear 19" and Front 21"
- c) Motorcycles of unrestricted capacity

3.10 MX Enduro

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 15th birthday - 125cc and over (must be competing in Enduro or Offroad locally).
- b) Motorcycles must be an enduro motorcycle with headlight.





3.11 SNR Support

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 16th birthday and older
- b) Non-Championship Class
- c) Motorcycles of unrestricted capacity

3.12 VMX Pre Motorcycle 75, 80, 85

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 38th birthday and older
- b) Only open to motorcycles from pre 1975 up to 1989
- c) Capacity classes for all of the above vintage groups for 125, 250 and 500 cc motorcycles.

3.13 VMX Motorcycle 90, 95

- a) Open to riders from the year of their 38th birthday and older
- b) Only open to motorcycles from 1990 to 1995
- c) Capacity classes for all of the above vintage groups for 125, 250 and 500 cc motorcycles.

Where classes are combined riders need to choose the class they would like to enter (a minimum of 3 per class to declare class championship; however it is entitled to withhold such declaration from any competition, should circumstances warrant such action).

4. REGULATIONS:

All qualifying events will be held under General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations of MSA (SSR's), MSA Circular(s) of 2018 and the event Supplementary Regulations (SR's) issued by the Club.

5. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS:

The Club Championship shall only be open to Club Members and only from date of membership. No points scored during the racing year prior to becoming a member will count towards the Club Championships.

6. RACE DURATION:

Races will be run over a course between .06km and 1.8km in length. Refer to the MSA Handbook.

7. FUEL:

Refer to SSR 256 in the 2018 MSA Handbook.

8. SCRUTINEERING:

Refer to Motocross SSR 226 in the 2018 MSA Handbook.





9. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

Refer to the SSR 225 and 228 in the 2018 MSA Handbook.

10. CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS TO COUNT:

The championship will comprise of six (6) rounds of two (2) races each per class, all races will count. **If less than six (6) races are run, then there will be NO championship.**

11. COMPETITION NUMBERS:

Competition numbers must be displayed in accordance with SSR 221 – 224 of the 2018 MSA Handbook and applicable bulletins issued by MSA in ALL regards.

12. POINTS TO SCORE:

Refer to SSR 244 in the 2018 MSA Handbook. Competing riders who are ineligible for the Club Championship will be ignored for the purpose of scoring Club Championship points. No race will score towards the Club Championship which fails to draw a minimum of 3 Club members' entries and starters for practice and for the first heat thereof. If a competitor is riding in a higher status event, already participating in that championship, they will be awarded average points towards the Club Championship.

13. SEPERATION OF TIES:

Refer Art 7 in the 2018 MSA Handbook and if this is ineffective Rover Motorcycle Club MX Committee will declare the winners on any basis they may deem fit.

14. ANNOUNCEMENT OF POINTS AWARDED:

Scoring for each race will be available for Rover Motorcycle Club Secretary on the Monday following the event. Any objections concerning the scoring must be in writing not later than the Friday following the Monday on which the scoring was available.

15. DECLARATION OF CHAMPIONSHIP:

Rover Motorcycle Club MX Committee as its sole discretion is responsible for declaring the winners of the championship or to withhold such declaration.

16. PENALTIES:

Refer to the GCR and SSR MSA Handbook 2018 and SR for the day's event.





17. PAYMENT AND ENTRIES:

Refer to SR's for each race date. Late entries, late payments and late arrivals for documentation will incur penalties. Any objection will be dealt with at the sole discretion of Rover Motorcycle Club MX Committee. Proof of payment must be emailed to the Club. No previous entry from a previous race date or membership at the Club guarantees entry to all races. Online entries on website www.racecontrol.co.za The Club reserves the right to reject an entry.

18. ENTRANT'S LICENCES:

Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's license's must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the programme. All competitors to present license's at documentation. **No verbal license numbers will be accepted. No license NO RIDE.**

19. TROPHIES:

Junior Classes will receive trophies for 1st – 3rd and the rest of the competitors will receive finisher medals.

Senior Classes will receive trophies for 1st – 3rd

Non-Championship Classes will receive Certificates or medals.

20. AMENDMENTS:

The Controllers reserve the right, to introduce new regulations and or amend the existing regulations. Any such amendment/addition to the regulations shall, however, only come into effect once it has been published in an official MSA circular/bulletin. Such changes to these Regulations **shall** be issued at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the next event being held. All additions / amendments will also be published on the official notice board at the next event.
